Surfside Beach will hold its second "Surf(side)'s Up Beach Art and Music Event" on Sunday, June 25. Last year was very successful, both in attendance and sales, and everyone who participated had a great time. This year's theme is "Found at the Beach." Artwork may be two or three dimensional and should represent a person, item or lifestyle associated with the beach. It can be made with found items, preferably from the beach environment- let your creative juices flow! Please, no "marsh" scenes!

Open to: All artists age 18 and older; all media. Work must be: Original work, museum quality, suitable for family audience; gallery wrapped or framed, dry, and ready to hang: wired – no saw-tooth hangers. Painting, sculpture, fabric art, photography, ceramics, stained glass, collage and mixed media are all acceptable.

Size: No larger than 36" X 36" Entry fee: \$10 for up to three submissions

How to enter:

- 1. Download online application at SurfsideBeach.org/calendar or visit Surfside Beach Town Hall for paper application.
- 2. Submit NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, JUNE 9 with entry fee to Town of Surfside Beach, 115 U.S. HWY. 17 N., Surfside Beach SC 29575. Include a photograph of each work with application, or send JPEG image(s) to martinkathryn@yahoo.com.
- 3. You will be notified by email (or by phone if you do not have email) if your work has been accepted, by Friday, June 16.
- 4. Submitted work must be delivered to Dick Johnson Civic Center from 10 11 a.m. Saturday, June 24.
- 5. Unsold work must be picked up between 6 and 7 p.m. on show day. Unclaimed work with be either donated or discarded. Any questions:
