The Board of Trustees, volunteers and staff of the Myrtle Beach Art Museum join us in extending healthy greetings to you and yours during the Covid-19 crisis. Looking back, the Museum's exciting and successful Ninth Annual Collectors' Event took place just three weeks before our country's shut-down. It is hard to believe how much has changed since then.

Our Ninth Annual Collectors' Event was such a great success, and we thank those of you who donated a work of your art in support of the Art Museum. Looking ahead to 2021 and the Tenth Annual Collectors' Event, it is necessary to make some changes to what is one of the Art Museum's most successful fundraisers.

Here is what has changed for 2021:

Love will be in the air along with wonderful art: This year's event will take place on Sunday, February 14, 2021 from 5 – 7 p.m as a virtual auction. In addition to the artwork being on display on our website, this year artists will have the exciting opportunity of having their artwork on display in the Art Museum's second floor galleries from Tuesday, January 5 through Saturday, February 13. Artists must commit to donating no later than October 15 to be included. Details of how to commit and how to submit artwork are included in this email along with all other details about the event.

Only original artwork (no prints) will be accepted and donations will be limited to one work per artist. As always, all artwork must be valued a minimum \$200.

Tickets will go on sale – beginning in mid-November, 2020. Ticket holders will have the chance to schedule a visit to the Art Museum to view the work and select their favorites.
