- Ocean Boulevard, from Eighth to 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue North, all lanes closed from 6:00 to 10:30 a.m.
- Ocean Boulevard, from 12<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> Avenue North, all lanes closed from 6:00 to 11:00 a.m.
- Ocean Boulevard, from 31<sup>st</sup> Avenue North to 52<sup>nd</sup> Avenue North, northbound curb lane closed from 6:00 to 11:00 a.m.
- North Ocean Boulevard, from Porcher Drive to 82<sup>nd</sup> Parkway, northbound lanes closed from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
- Grande Dunes Boulevard, from Ocean Boulevard to Kings Highway, eastbound lanes closed from 6:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
