Donna's hand woven wall hangings are made using as many up cycled and rescued fibers and materials as possible alongside new fibers and custom fibers. On some pieces she incorporates beach findings and other findings from her back yard. Her inspirations come from found materials, fibers, places she's been, emotions, written word, & nature.

The mixed media pieces can include: original written word, fibers, fabrics, paints and paper mediums. Every piece of art is one of a kind, the techniques Donna uses are mainly self taught, when starting something new she will read or take a class to learn the very basics, and then experiment on her own from there, making her art truly unique.

Donna hopes to either, resurface a happy memory for her viewers, or take them to a quiet place where they can feel at peace.

"Once upon a time I was a computer systems analyst, & hated it!

I've been self employed since 1989, first as a photographer, then full time artist since 1998.


# Important: Membership Renewal Reminder
